Applying Netting on Building Edges is Sometimes the Best Solution

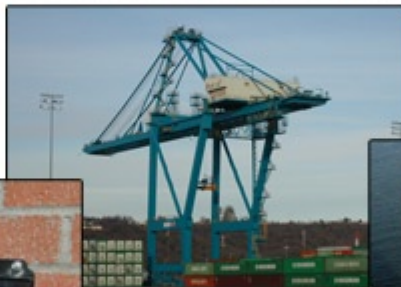

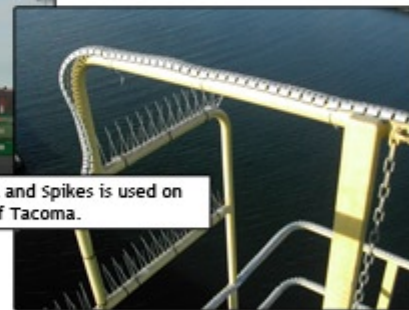


Netting Applied to the Underside Canopy of a Grocery Store Entrance to Eliminate Small Birds Nesting Above
