

Structural Pest Inspections

A Structural Pest Inspector looks for the presence of termites, carpenter ants, moisture ants, wood-infesting beetles and fungus (rot). Additionally, he or she looks for conducive conditions that may cause structural pests. These include earth to wood contact, plumbing leaks, moisture problems, lack of ventilation, damaged wood and subterranean termite tubes.
