Carpet Beetles

Carpet beetles are very common in the Pacific Northwest. The adults may be found outside feeding on flowers and the larva (caterpillar) stage may be found inside in a variety of sites – from feeding on your wool suits to infesting dry dog food or spices in the kitchen.

If the larva are found in food products the infested material should be thrown away. Care should also be taken to vacuum animal hair and debris that may accumulate under appliances and in cold air ducts.

If they are found in clothing everything should be removed from the drawers and closets. Infected articles can be brought to our vacuum fumigation chamber in the Seattle area and residual insecticides can be applied to the cracks and crevices in the home if clothing is removed.
